Each year, as part of our commitment to the arts, The Pennfield School hosts The Cornucopia Sale of Fine Arts and Quality Crafts at our beautiful campus on Little Slocum Farm in Portsmouth, RI. This event raises funds to support arts education at Pennfield, and also gives us the opportunity to promote local artists and craftsmen. We invite you to apply to participate in this special event.

The Pennfield School is easily accessible and has ample parking for artists and customers. We are committed to publicizing the event throughout the local area and beyond to ensure that the event is a rewarding one for all participants. We seek to showcase the talents of a diverse group of artisans whose hand-crafted products will appeal to a wide audience.

**Dates:** Cornucopia will open with a wine and hors d'oeuvres Preview Party on Friday, November 11, 2011 from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. The show will continue on Saturday, November 12th from 9:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.

**Fees:** Booth space is available for \$160. For an additional \$15, you may rent a table (8' x 2-1/2'). All booth spaces are 8' x 10' and very visible.

**Selection process:** Please return the enclosed application and fees along with quality photos of your crafts by **SEPTEMBER 15**. You may submit samples of your craft; these will be returned to you on the day of the show. If you are sharing a booth, each artist must submit photos of his or her work. This is a juried show. Applications will be reviewed by the Cornucopia Committee as they are received. You will be notified of the Committee's decision by October 1st. Please be aware that we seek to include only gallery-quality fine arts and **handmade** crafts.

If you would like your customers, friends, and families to receive invitations to attend Cornucopia, please include a mailing list with your application. We retain these lists from year to year, so you need only submit new names and addresses.
